This role requires a keen understanding of marine navigation, marine survey operations, and safety protocols to ensure the efficient and safe conduct of vessel operations.

Key Responsibilities

- Safely operate and navigate the survey vessel in compliance with regulations, client requirements and organizational policies.
- Conduct routine inspections of vessel systems and equipment to ensure functionality and compliance with safety standards.
- Carry out daily documentation and review and submission
- Liaison with PM team as well as client and third parties as required.

Safety and Compliance

- Adhere to all safety protocols, including the use of personal protective equipment (PPE), and ensure crew and relevant members aboard are familiar with safety procedures.
- Be knowledgeable and up-to-date Knowledge of regulations and compliance requirements associated with the SVCP program.

Vessel Maintenance

- Perform regular checks and minor maintenance and servicing of the vessel, including engines, electronics, and other operational systems.
- Report any mechanical or safety issues to the relevant support team promptly.

Administrative Responsibilities

- Maintain accurate logs of vessel operations, including navigation records, maintenance logs, and incident reports.
- Daily communication with project teams for safe vessel operations.
- Assist with inventory management for onboard supplies and equipment.

- Experience operating small vessels or similar marine vessels.
- Valid Small Vessel Operator Proficiency (SVOP) certification or better.
- Marine First Aid certification and other relevant safety training ie: MED etc...
- Knowledge of marine navigation.
- Strong understanding of Transport Canada regulations and compliance for small vessels.
- Excellent communication and teamwork abilities.
- Ability to work in varying weather conditions and perform physically demanding tasks.

Skills

- Proficient in the use of navigational equipment and radios.
- Proficient in Microsoft office.
- Strong problem-solving skills and attention to detail.
- Ability to work independently and manage time effectively.
- Basic mechanical skills for vessel maintenance.

Working Conditions

- This position requires working on water, sometimes in remote or challenging conditions.

- Flexibility in work hours may be needed.
- Participation in ongoing training and professional development as needed.
- Options to participate in training and renewal programs for various certificates.
